Job Title: Journeyman Lineman

JOB SUMMARY: This position is responsible for the construction, operation, and maintenance of overhead and underground electrical distribution systems.

JOURNEYMAN LINEMAN ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Responsible for all phases of underground and overhead electric distribution.
- Performs rubber glove work on energized 15KV.
- Responsible for connecting, splicing, and insulating high voltage wires and cables.
- Performs all types of hot stick work up to 138KV to include fusing and installation of hot line clamps.
- Performs work on all types of energized underground and overhead construction.
- Installs transformers, circuit breakers, switches, and other equipment to control and direct the electrical current.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS & SKILLS:

- Successfully completed an approved 4-year Lineman Apprenticeship.
- Ability to climb poles up to 90 feet and work underground in confined spaces.
- Ability to lift a maximum of 100 pounds.
- Requires a Class A CDL.
- Must be able to fulfill on-call rotation and able, at times, to work any time of day or night and any day of the year for emergency purposes.
- Must have high school diploma.
- Must establish and maintain residency 10 miles within Peru city limits within six months of hire date.
